JOIN US FOR A CONGREGATIONAL MEETING - JUNE 4

Please plan to stay on **June 4** for a Congregational Meeting at 11:15am. We will receive updates on the Capital Campaign and be asked to approve taking out a short term loan to cover expenses so that projects can be accomplished without delay. You will remember that gifts to the Capital Campaign can be paid over the next three years. But, we don't want to wait three years to do the projects. So, the board is asking the congregation to approve loans of up to \$200,000 (\$250,000 total campaign minus the current cash on hand). The board will only take out loans in the amount we need and loans will be paid in full in three years (at the end of the campaign) or sooner if funds are available. Kent Clark, our Capital Campaign team chair, will share more about expected project timelines and funding options at the meeting. The meeting will be hybrid, so you can sign on using Zoom.

It's camp and this summer we are sending 23 kids to camp at the Christian Conference Center.
